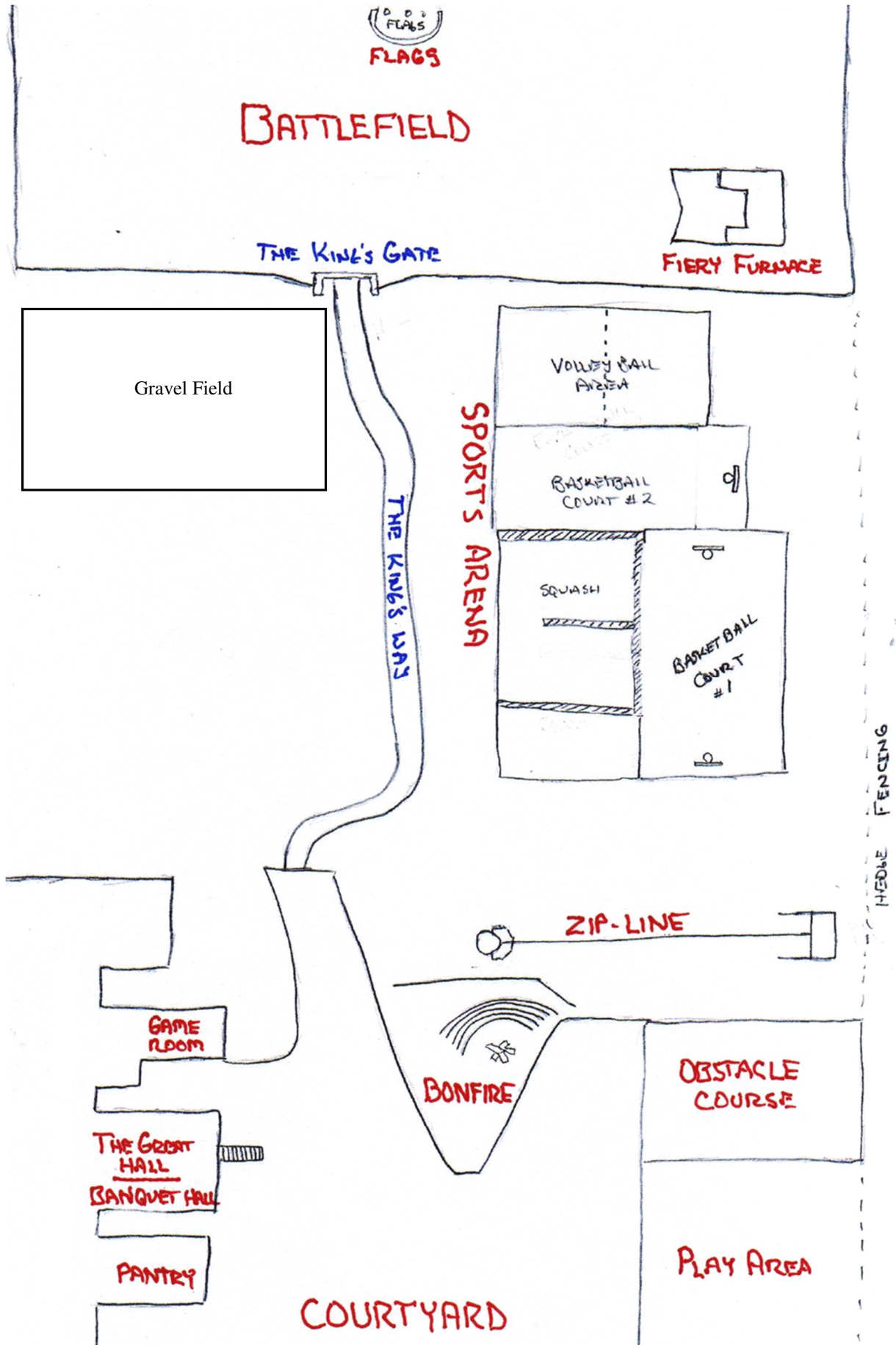


Camp Room Layout Map

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Rules You Have to Obey While At Camp

1. The Camp Director and leaders will be obeyed at all times.
2. No one is allowed to go outside of the Camp grounds without permission from the Camp Director – period!
3. All mobiles will be turned into either your pastor, or to the Camp Director upon arrival at camp. Use of mobile phones will be allowed once a day and will be strictly monitored. If you are using a mobile phone inappropriately, then you risk losing it, and you will lose points for both yourself, and your team. If your parents need to contact you, they must ring either your pastor or the Camp Director.
4. Keep your Camper Handbook, put your name on it – don't lose it!
5. Don't leave your stuff lying around.
6. Keep your hands off other people's stuff
7. Every meal, a team will be selected to wash the dishes and clean the dining hall – do your tasks without complaining – the better the attitude, the more the points!
8. No profanity will be allowed
9. No rock or worldly music will be played at all at camp – Camp Director decides
10. No *boy and girl* things going on
11. No knives – if you have one, give it to your pastor, or to the Camp Director until Camp is over and he will return it.

How to Earn Points

Getting Points (Be sure to have your handbook signed and dated by a counsellor when points have been given)

- Every Scripture verse you memorize, you get 100 points!
- If you memorize all the 10 key verses you get 1,000 Extra points!
- If you memorize ALL the verses, you will get 2,000 extra points on top of them!
- The first full team present and seated for Chapel gets 500 points! Every time!
- Every Team Cheer, or Skit will get points for that team based on how good they are!
- Clean Bunks will result in 100 points being given to the person.
- A completed Bible Word Dictionary will result in 1,000 points for that person.
- Every Sermon or lesson that you take a full page of notes on will get you 500 pts.
- Every Devotion Page completed will get 500 points.
- Every time the Camp Director sees a person with great zeal, they will get 500 pts.
- Every Science Station Questionnaire completed will get 500 points.

Losing Points – unless stated, breaking any of these rules has a limit of three warnings

- Every time someone on your team has a bad attitude, breaks a rule, or gets into a fight, they will lose 1000 points.
- Every bed must be made and every room cleaned before breakfast – or else each person who leaves a messy bunk will lose 100 points.
- Arguing with a camp leader/counsellor will cost you 500 points.
- No one ever goes out of the camp unless they are given permission by the Camp Director. If you leave camp grounds without permission, you will be sent home.

- Anyone with more than three warnings will be sent home.
- Anyone caught messing with the fire alarms will be sent home!!!!

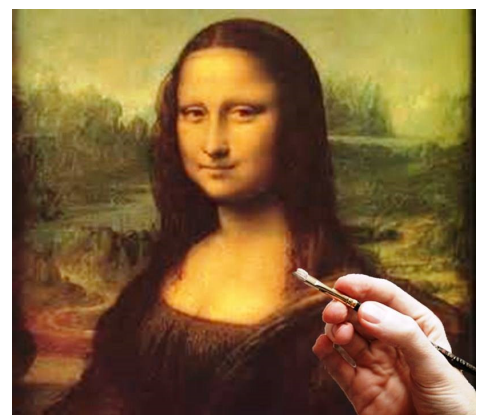

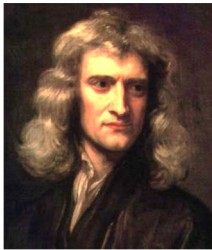
Smart People Believe the Bible

“I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy testimonies are my meditation.” Psalm 119:99

Here are some famous scientists and what they discovered, designed and built, because they believed the Bible.

Johann Kepler - *Physical Astronomy and Celestial Mechanics*

Johann Kepler is best known for discovering the three mathematical laws of planetary motion, dubbed “Kepler’s Laws,” that established the movement of celestial mechanics (everything in the sky). He revolutionized scientific thought by applying physics to astronomy. Kepler defended Nicolaus Copernicus’ theory of heliocentrism (sun at the centre) and sought to reconcile it with Scripture.



Isaac Newton - *Calculus and Dynamics*

As a young scientist and mathematician, Sir Isaac Newton invented the generalized binomial theorem and began developing the mathematical theory that would later become calculus. His 1687 work, *The Mathematical Principles of Natural Philosophy*, is considered today the single greatest work in the history of science. In it he described universal gravitation and the three laws of motion, derived from Kepler’s Laws.

Robert Boyle - *Chemistry and Gas Dynamics*

Robert Boyle conducted scientific research into air pressure, mechanics, and chemistry—which he believed should no longer be a subordinate study of alchemy and medicine. He laid the foundation for the atomic theory of matter in *The Sceptical Chymist*, the cornerstone work for modern chemistry. He co-founded the prestigious Royal Society in 1663.

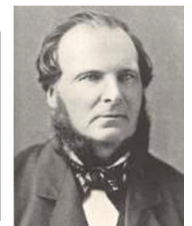


Charles Bell - *Anatomy and Surgery*

Charles Bell had particular interest in the human body’s nervous system, and he published *Idea of a New Anatomy of the Brain* in 1811, now considered the “Magna Carta of neurology.” Several discoveries are named for him, including Bell’s Nerve, Bell’s Palsy/Paralysis, Bell’s Phenomenon, and Bell’s Spasm. His scientific endeavours of the human body convinced him of the existence and necessity of the Creator.

William Kirby – *Entomology (The Study of Insects)*

William Kirby and fellow British entomologist William Spence authored the four-volume *An Introduction to Entomology: or Elements of the Natural History of Insects*, considered the foundational work in the field of entomology.

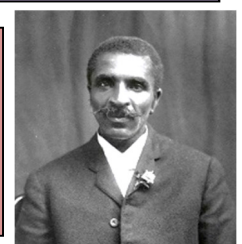


Louis Pasteur - *Microbiology, Bacteriology, Biogenesis Law, Pasteurization, Vaccination and Immunization*

We owe all the discoveries in the fields of microbiology and immunology to his work. He shares the title of “father of germ theory and bacteriology” with German physician Robert Koch. Two of his main contributions to science and medicine are the anthrax and rabies vaccines.

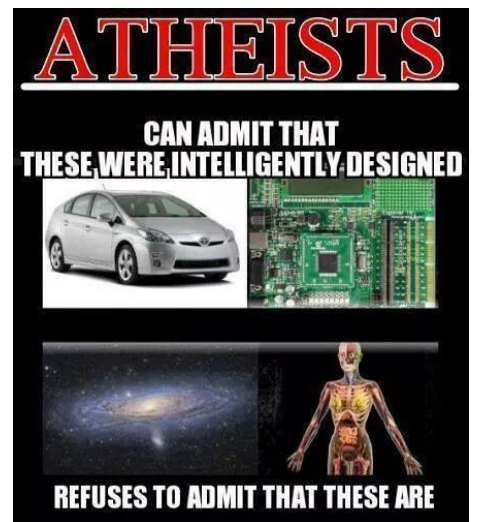
George Washington Carver - *Modern Agriculture*

George Washington Carver revolutionized agricultural science with his cultivation of soil-enriching crops, such as peanuts and soybeans, to revive earth that had been depleted of nutrients from cotton farming. He discovered over 100 uses for the sweet potato and 300 uses for the peanut.

Who am I?

Many young people start off on the wrong foot in life because they do not know their Creator - God. They do not realize just how special they are in the eyes of God. But when we finally read God's Book, the Bible, we learn how God made us in His "_____ " – with His *likeness* on the inside of us. Let's see what the Bible says in the first book, Genesis, about who you are!



1. Genesis 1:26-28; 2:7, 21, 22 Read and fill in...

- **Man was created by God.** "... _____ and _____ created he them." **That's it!** In the beginning, God made a man and a woman. And so, we all are a creation of God.
- **You were created in the image of God.** "... So God created man in his own _____, in the image of God created he him;" In God's likeness. Just like God is a three part being (Father, Son, Holy Spirit), He made us as three parts too! We have a **body**, a **soul**, and a **spirit**. Which parts are invisible? (Circle the parts that are invisible)
- **God gave me a soul!** – Adam was "... formed of the _____ of the ground." It was God who "...breathed into his nostrils the _____; and man became a living _____." **The Soul** is the eternal, invisible part of you that thinks, feels, loves, hates, wishes and prays. It is who you are. Your body is a covering for your soul. And your spirit is what God gave you to talk to Him with.
- **God's love and blessings are upon you.** "...And God _____ them...". God has poured His lovingkindness upon mankind and upon you in particular. Every day God feeds, protects, and watches over you. He gave you parents who love you and sent His Son to die for your sins. What else does He do for you? _____
- **He wants me to** "...be _____ and _____, and _____(fill up) the _____." Someday, Lord willing, you will grow up, marry someone, and have a family of your own. That is being fruitful, multiplying, and bringing forth life into this world. God loves life - it is precious to Him. God desires us to enjoy His creation and to fill it with life. Your life is precious to God. With Jesus, your life can be precious to you!

2. Psalm 8:3-6 It is amazing when you consider everything the Lord God has made, and that He takes such delight, and is so attentive to you and me. But, that is the wonder of it all. We are His greatest and dearest creation. God loves the world so much He sent His Son to die for mankind! So, what is God's favourite creation of all? _____

- **You were made a little lower than the angels of heaven.** That doesn't mean we are less important, but that we are weaker and inferior in some things compared to the angels. Yet, man is crowned (honoured) by God. **Verse 5** says "...and hast crowned him with _____ and _____." The Lord pays great attention to you as an individual. He loves you!
- **God wants man** "...to have _____ over the works of thy hands". God gave man power and authority over the earth and all living things. You have a responsibility as the highest and greatest creation of God to know about, and care for the world that God made.

Conclusion. Psalm 139:13, 14 tells us that "...I am _____ and _____ made." God made you as His greatest masterpiece. You are not an accident of nature or something that evolved from some ancient animal. Your great, great, great, great, grandfather was not a monkey. You are a creation of the Almighty Creator, a design of the Designer, and a masterpiece of the Master. You are made in His image and likeness and you have a purpose in life. Take two minutes and thank God for making you, and giving you life!

Wednesday Morning Devotions – God's Purpose for My Life

Scripture – Revelation 4:11

Introduction: The verse above clearly tells us that we human beings were created for God's "_____." The way we live our lives should cause God to be pleased with what He sees in us, His creation. He alone gives us the purpose for living and He alone determines what His creation should do. When we choose to do our own thing, and by going our own way, apart from God's will, then we are displeasing to God, our Creator. Take some time today and think about the following Bible scriptures and God's personal will or purpose for your life.



Ephesians 1:11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the _____ of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

Read each of the following verses to find out some specific things God wants for your life.

1. **God's wants everyone to be _____.** **2 Peter 3:9** says God is "not willing that any should _____, (die) but that all should come to _____." The Lord wants EVERYONE to be saved! And that means YOU too! The Bible says we must repent; meaning to feel very sorry inside our hearts about our own sinful acts. Jesus died for the punishment for those sins and He doesn't want any of us to die (perish) without being saved. Those who die without the forgiveness of Jesus Christ have only hell to look forward to.
2. **God wants His people to _____ Him.** **Psalm 2:11** says "_____ the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling." It is God's will that I serve Him all the days of my life. Doing things for God is honouring to Him and that is what serving Him should be.
3. **God wants Christians to tell others the _____.** **Mark 16:15** says "And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and _____ the _____ to every creature." Preparing for Eternity

Scripture – 2 Peter 3:9-11 *Vs. 10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.*

There is an end to all things, a “Big Bang!” But it is God who will bring all things to an end. The Bible in **2 Peter 3:10** tells us the Lord will come when least expected, and that we should prepare now for that time. The Scripture tells us that the heavens above and the very earth beneath our feet will one day burn up - and everything in-between! You must make a decision now as to where you stand in your relationship to this awesome and Holy God.



Question 1 – Are you saved? What does the Bible say about being saved?

- **Romans 3:23** “For _____ have _____, and come short of the glory of God;”. You are a sinner before a Holy God! **Why?** The verse says that all have **sinned** and that includes you. You are a sinner! Just admit it to God!
- **Romans 6:23a** “For the wages of sin is _____ ...”. **Wages** means that what you have earned for being a sinner is **death**. That is what you get in return for doing sinful things.
- **Romans 6:23b** “... but the _____ of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” Salvation is not something we earn by doing good works, but by believing and trusting in the perfect sacrifice of Jesus Christ and His forgiveness.
- **Romans 5:8** “But God _____ toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” To commend is to give something to someone. God gave His Son Jesus dying in your place at Calvary. My friend do you realize how much God loves you?!?
- **Romans 10:9** “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt _____ that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be _____.” You must believe Jesus died on the Cross for your sins and that He rose again and has the power to forgive and give you eternal life. He must be trusted completely. No one else! Will you put **YOUR faith / trust** in Jesus alone to be saved?
- **Romans 10:13** “For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord _____.” To be saved you must believe on Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour, and then ask Him to save you. Call upon His name and He will hear. The Bible says He will save you if you humble yourself and ask Him to!

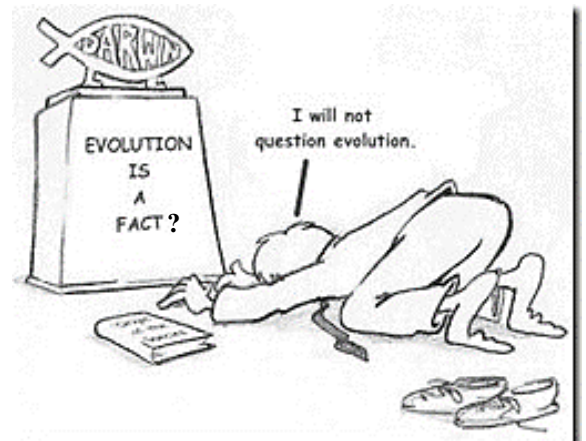

Science Stations

There are Eight Science Stations to choose from every day.

1. **THE UNIVERSE** (Psalm 19:1) [Craig Ledbetter](#)
Goal of this Station: This Station will show that the heavens show HANDIWORK, and DESIGN, and to demonstrate the superiority of Biblical Creation vss a Big Bang.
Main Project – Hike the size of the Solar System to Scale, As well as Night Sky Viewing at Night. Discover What's Up There above the clouds – using telescopes, binoculars, and star charts. Identify constellations, planets, the Milky Way in the night sky
2. **OUR PLANET EARTH** (Isaiah 45:18) [Paige Fenton](#)
Goal of this Station: To show just how special this planet of our is! That the entire planet is designed, and works quite well! That only the Earth was designed for life!
Main Project – Compare all planets with the earth, and show there is no life on any of them – only the earth was created to be inhabited!
3. **DINOSAURS, FOSSILS AND THE FLOOD** (2Peter 3:6) [Dan Eberly](#)
Goal of this Station: Show that dinosaurs did NOT live 65 million years ago. They were created when Adam was. Most died off in the flood, and a few lived until recently, and were called Dragons!

Main Project – Make a living Lego Man!
6. **D.N.A. – GOD'S LANGUAGE OF LIFE** (John 1:3,4) [Nathan Volfango](#)
Goal of this Station: To show and prove that every cell, every living thing is amazingly designed to live because of D.N.A. – THE most advanced computer programming language ever imagined! Unduplicatable
Main Project - Build a small portion of a DNA Molecule, and then eat it!
7. **THE INVISIBLE THINGS OF CREATION** (Colossian 1:16) [Frank Allison III](#)
