

**ANSWER KEY**

*A Listing of the Answers to all the fill in the Blanks and Tests in this Study Guide*

What follows looks kind of cryptic, but is just an easy way to list the answers to the blanks in this kind of a study. The first thing you will notice is the Chapter Title and Heading (i.e., **Lesson One** – Biblical Salvation). Following that, on each line is the location of the question blank, as follows:

VI.A.1.b. hand

The first part locates where the blank is – **Section VI**. Each roman numeral (I, II, III, IV, etc.) is used in the study outline as a main topic. Find the part of the lesson that starts with the roman numeral VI (six), and then look down until you find the paragraph starting with capital ‘A.’ Under that, the paragraph marked ‘1.’ will have a subparagraph marked, small ‘b.’ at its start. In THAT paragraph, is the statement with the blank you are checking your answer against. Now, thankfully, not all of the answers are in sections so deep, with so many sub-sections, but you see how it works. There can be a few blanks that are actually not part of a paragraph that is numbered, so, the previous section number will be used.

Two other points need to be made concerning answers.

1. Usually there is only one answer that is correct for the fill in the blank, so one answer will be listed. But if another answer would be acceptable, it will be listed in parenthesis brackets “(...)”.
2. If there are more than one fill in the blank in a paragraph for you to locate answers for, the answers will simply be separated by semi-colons (;).

Please – if you are looking *here* for the answers to the fill-in the blanks of the Study Guide, you are looking in the wrong place. The answers are found in the Bible, in the Scripture location referred to in the study. Always look there first!
